



Deafblind International Technology Network AI Use Policy.

Effective Date: October 19, 2025

1. Purpose and Scope

This policy guides the ethical and inclusive use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) by the Deafblind International Technology Network (DBI Tech Network), a global volunteer community. We use AI tools solely to support content creation aligned with our mission of accessibility, inclusion, and knowledge-sharing. No personal or sensitive data is used in our AI processes.

2. Guiding Principles

We commit to using AI in ways that are:

- **Inclusive:** Respecting diverse access needs, languages, and cultural contexts.
- **Transparent:** Clearly stating when content is AI-assisted.
- **Ethical:** Avoiding bias, discrimination, or harm in any AI-generated output.
- **Human-reviewed:** All AI-generated content will be reviewed by a human before publication whenever possible.

3. Data and Privacy

- We do not input personal, private, or sensitive data into AI tools.
- Our approach reflects ethical AI principles, including respect for intellectual property, data privacy, and the integrity of human authorship.

4. Use of AI-Generated Content

- AI may be used to draft educational materials, reports, or communications.
- All outputs will be reviewed by a human editor before sharing.
- If human review is not possible, content will be clearly marked as “AI-generated, not yet reviewed.”

5. Governance and Review

- This policy will be reviewed annually or as needed to reflect evolving technologies and global legal standards.
